Even in other offences like assault, our courts have espoused the need to exercise caution when dealing with the evidence of a single witness. Child Victims or Witnesses Reserved. If there are major or material aspects of the testimony of that witness are unsatisfactory, this must be indicated in the defence address.

The judge may appoint one or more expert witnesses of his own selection to give evidence. In jury cases, proceedings shall be conducted, to the extent practicable, so as to facilitate the making of claims of privilege without the knowledge of the jury. He may testify that he witnessed one or more of the other accused commit the crime.
